

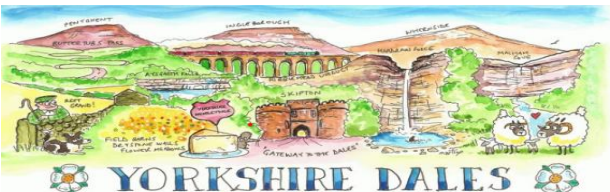
	STORT VALLEY RAMBLERS WALKING PROGRAMME 6th April – 29th June 2025
